Studio Entries Only – Individual Entries Will Not Be Accepted

Category:

1. Character Ballet/Demi-Character:
Portraying a specific idea, person, theme or thing. Uses classical and/or character techniques. Props may be used.
2. Classical Ballet:
Using classical soft shoe ballet technique, with no lyrics allowed in the music.
3. Pointe:
Using classical technique or portraying an idea or theme.
4. Jazz:
Using jazz technique. Props may be used.
5. Lyrical Jazz:
Using ballet/jazz/modern techniques. Props may be used.
6. Musical Theatre:
Dance suitable for stage. May use lip synching. Music containing tapping is not allowed.
7. Tap:
Using tap techniques. No jingle taps allowed. Props may be used. Music containing tapping is not allowed.
8. Song and Dance:
Live voice. No lip synching allowed. No background vocals. Props may be used.
9. Hip Hop:
Similar to jazz, but having a funkier style with more free style dance moves. Props may be used.
10. Contemporary:
A dance portraying freedom of expression and movement containing contemporary technique.

Timing:

Solos 2-1/2 minutes maximum
Musical Theatre Solos 2-1/2 minutes maximum
Duets 3 minutes maximum
Small Groups 4 minutes maximum
Large Groups..... 4 minutes maximum

Upon completion of your music, please exit the stage. No re-entries or encores.

Groups:

1. 4 years & under
2. 5 & 6 years
3. 7 & 8 years
4. 9 & 10 years
5. 11 & 12 years
6. 13 & 14 years
7. 15 & 16 years
8. 17 & 18 years & over
9. Senior Dancers: 19 years and over or any age who has finished high school and teachers who do not attend high school
10. Solos: age of dancer as of December 31, 2008
11. Duets: age determined by oldest dancer
12. Small Groups: 3 – 7 dancers, average age of all dancers
13. Large Groups: 8 or more dancers, average age of all dancers
14. The age of the contestant shall be considered as of December 31, 2008

Competitors may enter only once in any one age class, and shall not enter an award winning dance from previous years.

GOOD SPORTSMANSHIP MUST BE DISPLAYED AT ALL TIMES OR YOU MAY BE DISQUALIFIED.

Novice: any dancer who has never danced on stage in competition in any classification before the 2008/2009 season. If any member of a group has competed before, the group is not novice.

Senior dancers are not eligible for awards or scholarships.

All teachers, regardless of age, who enter solos or duets under the studio they teach at shall be regarded as senior dancer entries.

Cassettes, CD, MP3 or Ipod may be used to play music. Teachers or their designates are responsible for their students music.

NO PHOTOGRAPHY OR VIDEOTAPING WILL BE ALLOWED IN THE GYM DURING DANCE MANIA. There will be zero-tolerance, and the offender will be removed for the duration of the competition. Cellular phones, Black Berries and other devices must be silenced before entering the gym.

Absolutely no tap shoes allowed anywhere but on stage. Any dance club causing damage to the floors will be billed accordingly.

An unsupervised practice room is available. You must supply your own music.

All dance clubs will be provided with a classroom for their use during the competition, but must provide their own adult supervision.

All dance clubs will be expected to keep their rooms clean by using the garbage containers provided.

All dancers shall be ready to go on stage 1/2 hour before scheduled dancing time.

A canteen will be opened for the duration of the competition to serve lunch and snacks, as well as designated eating areas. No food or drink allowed in gymnasium.

Preference will be given to studios that submit group entries. Dance Mania Committee reserves the right to combine categories.

Entry Forms:

Only one entry per form. Fill in the form completely. Please give dancers' age as of December 31, 2009.

Group entries must indicate names and ages of all contestants on the form and be averaged. Group dances must be named. Specific name for each entry.

Entry forms are to be completed and submitted by dance instructors only, and must be accompanied by a cheque to cover all entries from that participating club. There will be no refunds on cancellations.

Changes in entries to the competition will be accepted until January 8, 2010. Changes, with the exception of cancellations, will not be accepted after this date.

Entries will be accepted by mail only.
